LEGAL NOTICE

NOTICE

Norvell Township Ordinance
Number Five

As authorized by State of Michigan Statute the Norvell Township Board has adopted the following Township Ordinance.

Licensing of:

1. Entertainment Enterprises
2. Solicitors
3. Hawkers

4. Venders and Peddlers, shall be regulated by the Norvell Township Board of Norvell Township of Jackson, State of Michigan.

Application for this license shall be secured from the Township Clerk and submitted fully documented to Township Board (at their regular Monthly meeting) for Approval.

Cost of this license shall be \$12.50.

All licenses granted under this ordinance shall expire on Dec. 31st of the year in which they may be granted.

When this ordinance becomes effective it shall be illegal to operate a business as specified in Paragraph 2, unless a current years license is obtained as ordered and further that each license is displayed in the place of business or carried on the person who is licensed to conduct a specified business.

Penalties for Violation may be full suspension of Operation and the offender may further be subject to a fine of (\$100.00) one hundred dollars or imprisonment in the county Jail for (90 days) Ninety days or both.

This Ordinance was adopted on the 24th day of July 1969, and ordered to take effect after a lapse of thirty (30) days from its publication in The Exponent, a newspaper having general circulation within Norvell Township, Jackson County, Michigan.
