HOMEOWNER'S ELECTRICAL PERMIT

Homeowner Definition: A homeowner is a person who occupies or will occupy a single-family dwelling.

Electrical Code Rules, Part 8: Section 90-13 c defines a home as:

A homeowner who occupies or will occupy a single-family dwelling and other accessory structures located on the same lot intended for is by the homeowner for which the permit is obtained and who will install the electrical equipment as certified by the homeowner on the permit application in accordance with section 10 (4) of the 1972PA30, MCL S125.1510 (4)

All work shall be installed in accordance with the Electrical Code and shall not be enclosed, covered up, or put into operation until it has been inspected and approved by the electrical inspector.
